

Taiwan is U.S.'s 10th largest trading partner (2016) Two-way trade: \$66.1 billion (2016) U.S. investment in Taiwan: \$23.7 billion Taiwan investment in U.S.: \$14.5 billion 2016 Two-way trade: \$60.45 million (-5.40%) Taiwan is Hawaii's 10th export market and 12th import source (2016)


