CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chair Kalani Ka'anā'anā at 03:07 p.m., who welcomed everyone present via ZOOM.

Chair Ka'anā'anā conducted the roll-call attendance. Chair Ka'anā'anā, Commissioner Asher, Commissioner Kippen, Commissioner Lum, and Commissioner McClellan were present via Zoom.

Commissioner Bento, Commissioner de Silva, Commissioner Keohokālole and Commissioner Onishi were excused.

WEHENA

The Chair called upon Commissioner Lum to provide the wehena (opening) who introduced Kumu Lāhela Ka'aihue for the wehena.

Kumu Lāhela Ka'aihue started in her wehena that she was a part of the very first FestPAC in Tahiti and she was very happy to be a part of it. She shared that the commission has a big job on their hand and that she's so happy it's going ot be in Hawai'i and wants to make sure it's publicized so people can attend. Kumu Lāhela Ka'aihue then shared the 'oli Ka Lei Maila.

Also in attendance were Deputy Attorney General Elise Amemiya, Festival Director (FD) Aaron Salā, as well as HTA support staff: Maka Casson-Fisher.

PUBLIC TESTIMONY ON AGENDA ITEMS

No testimony was received in advance of the day's meeting. The chair invited members of the public to testify on the agenda items. Hearing none, he continued with agenda items.

REPORT ON PERMITTED INTERACTIONS, PURSUANT TO ACT 103, SESSION LAWS OF HAWAI'I 2021

Chair shared that the Programming/Venue Committee met on Tuesday, October 17. Hearing no additional meetings, the Chair continued with the next agenda item.

APPROVAL OF THE OCTOBER 6, 2023 MEETING MINUTES

The minutes were previously distributed and reviewed by Commissioners. Chair Ka'anā'anā requested a motion to adopt the October 6, 2023 minutes. Commissioner Lum motioned and it was Seconded by Commissioner McCllelan. With no additional discussion, Chair Ka'anā'anā conducted a roll-call vote. Chair Ka'anā'anā, and Commissioners Asher, Kippen, Lum, and McClellan voted in favor of approving the unamended minutes of the October 6th, 2023 meeting. Commissioner Bento, Commissioner de Silva, Commissioner Keohokālole and Commissioner Onishi were excused. Motion passed.

Festival Director Salā provided an update regarding the following items:

FD is working with SPC for bi-weekly circulars. The FestPAC website is up along with a delegation portal for the Heads of Delegations to login to receive up-to-date information. FS is working on follow-ups on countries' intent to participate form as 17 of the 28 countries invited have accepted the invitation. There is currently a call for young ambassadors along with the Visual Arts exhibit at Capitol Modern along with the 50th Anniversary exhibit there as well.

They are also looking to find festival goers throughout the years to provide to the anniversary exhibit in partnership with the University of Hawai'i.



FD is finalizing how to invite particular dignitary and traditional leaders as well to ensure proper protocol. Council of Chiefs in Fiji would like to have a meeting of traditional leaders in early 2024 and looking to FestPAC's list of traditional leaders for them to invite as well.


FD had meetings for accommodations for secondary venues for rooming.

FD continues to meet with Biosecurity committee and make great strides in confirming the logistics of transport of items and materials to and from Hawai'i.





For Marketing & Promotions, FD is working with Stryker Weiner & Yokota (SWAY) on a press release while collecting contact emails from the website. FD has also begun to make more traction through Social Media through Facebook, Instagram, and X (formerly known as Twitter). A member of the Gravitas Pasifika team will also be traveling to the East Coast for a Media Blitz sharing the news of FestPAC while United States-based publications.

Commissioner Lum has asked how many actual delegates will be joining, which FD shared about 1,300 delegates.

Chair Ka'anā'anā shared that with his Festival Director report, FD has shared agenda item #7 and 8. Chair also asked that they needed to revisit the MOA to meet with SPC once their plan is in place for broadcasting.
