

During the Town Cleanup on the south shore of O'ahu, we removed over 5000 lbs of land-based debris with the help of over 500 volunteers. Of the 5000+ lbs, 42 lbs will be recycled by Bottles4College, and 760 lbs of metal will be recycled by Schnitzer Steel. Other unique numbers that stood out to us were:

- 417 plastic + foam takeout containers
- 12 lbs of plastic film + wrappers
- 231 bottle caps
- 317 plastic bottles
- 103 plastic utensils + straws
- 2,008 cigarette butts
