To Be Hawai'i is a Maui-based, Hawai'i-inspired natural personal care company founded in 2018 by Karli Rose Suprea-Wilson. Sourcing ingredients directly from several Maui farms, personal care items are manufactured in their Wailuku factory and sold direct-to-consumer and to a few wholesale accounts. The company is seeking financing to grow and transition from artisan-scale to mainstream manufacturer thus increase their wholesale production capacity and ability to meet international production specifications. Co-lending with Feed the Hunger Fund (FTHF), which will also make a loan of \$75,000; loan total will be \$150,000. CBED loan would cover the cost of manufacturing equipment and working capital with the following terms: 6 years at 5.5%. Underwriting review by Eric Bowman, Loan Officer, FTHF.
